

## GRAEAGLE MEN'S GOLF ASSOCIATION HOLE-IN-ONE POLICY

The Graeagle Men's Golf Association (GMGA) Hole-in-One Policy is a reimbursement based program. Under the policy a "player" (as defined) will be reimbursed the cost of buying drinks for members of GMGA, Graeagle Meadows Women's Golf Club and eligible persons on the day the hole-in-one is scored. The hole-in-one must be accomplished during a round of golf at Graeagle Meadows Golf Course or at another golf course in a GMGA sanctioned event as identified in the front of the annual directory, and witnessed by two other players. If the hole-in-one is not witnessed by two other players, approval of the Board of Directors is required. The maximum reimbursement shall be limited to the actual cost of the drinks up to a maximum of \$1.50 per current members. (150 members x \$1.50 = maximum of \$225)

### Definitions

**Player:** A "player" is a member in good standing of the GMGA. All members shall pay the hole-in-one fee at the time they join, or rejoin, GMGA and may be assessed an additional fee, if the fund becomes depleted, as determined by the Board of Directors

**Member:** A member shall include all regular dues paying members, and Lifetime Achievement members (LAM's). LAM's are not required to pay the fee. Any complimentary members must pay the fee to be eligible.

**Round of Golf:** A round of golf shall include all forms of play that occur over at least 9 holes and may include a temporary tee, but not a temporary green.

**Reimbursement:** The player scoring a hole-in-one will be responsible for paying the bar tab for the drinks purchased on the day of the hole-in-one. In order to be reimbursed the player must insure that the score card authenticating the hole-in-one is signed, dated and accompanied by a receipt showing the amount the player paid for drinks for eligible persons. The receipt and score card shall be placed in the GMGA entry box in the club house, so that the GMGA Treasurer may reimburse the player as soon as possible.
